


Santa Barbara Model A Ford Club Monthly Meeting Minutes April 3, 2024

New Business: Announcements of upcoming events: Ladies' Day will be held April 20th at Fred & Cyndy Duerner's ranch. The Ladies' picnic will be April 9th .

There was a lot of discussion about donating to some kind of a scholarship for automotive students at SBCC or in an automotive program at one of the local high schools. MODEL A Era Fashion

Dress clips were the most important jeweled accessory during the Great Depression

1930s jewelry includes pendant earrings, necklaces, bracelets, and brooches, as well as new types of jewels – dress clips and double-clip brooches. In fact, dress clips were <u>the</u> most important jeweled accessory during the Great Depression. Costume jewelry makers also produced *fruit salads*, molded glass that imitated carved gemstones popularized by fine jewelers such as Cartier. Bakelite and other plastics were used to create whimsical jewelry in every possible form. The Art Deco style continued to evolve, with

new motifs and streamlining. By decade's end, Machine Age (aka Streamline

Modern) jewelry was in vogue.

On the Facebook MAFCA page, Top Contributor **David Berger** posted: Here's a head scratcher... A neighbor's 1931 Fordor, front passenger door has a lock underneath the handle (not integrated into the handle). Today, the door seemingly locked itself shut, and there's no key (of course). We can't figure out what happened or how to get it open, aside from picking the lock maybe? I thought there was supposed to be door lock levers located on the doors inside, but I'm not seeing those either. Just a window crank and the door latch on each door. Holy crow, now what??

The inside slide lock could have been loose and when you closed the door the slide nob made it lock. Four door sedan have the locks in the door. There is a slide nob inside near the back edge of the door that wont help you. So you will have to get a locksmith to get it open. After that, the lock cylinder separate from the door handle is reproduced and comes with a key. Easy to swap out.




