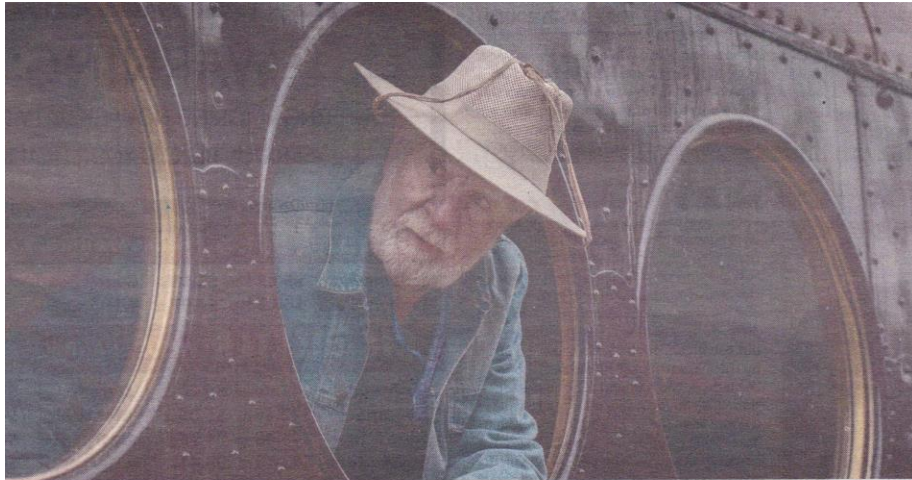
This year I am sorry to report that the Jewel City model A club will not be holding their annual July 4th picnic festivity so members will be able to celebrate with family and friends as they like!
