THE STEERING WHEEL PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE - NOVEMBER, 2024

Greetings, Diamond Tread Chapter members!

On December 2, 1927, Ford introduced the Model A, which was a complete redesign that replaced the Model T.

The Model A was a more sophisticated, modern vehicle with features like hydraulic shock absorbers, a three-speed manual transmission, and a more powerful engine. It came in several body styles, including a coupe, sedan, roadster, and truck.

The Model A offered significant improvements over its predecessor, including enhanced styling and a smoother ride. It also included safety features like laminated safety glass for the windshield.

The public eagerly embraced the Model A, with Ford selling over one million units by February 1929. By July 1929, sales had reached two million. This success helped Ford regain its competitive edge in the automotive market.







