Our tour was led by a docent (Trina) who gave a full introduction of what the museum was all about, what we would be seeing, and what was offered in the 'lab' area there at the museum.


The Museum Of Neon Art encourages learning, curiosity and expression through the preservation, collection, and interpretation of neon, electricity and kinetic art since 1981. In this facility, they restore historic neon signs and artworks while educating about the science, history and art of neon, so that future generations can keep the craft and our collective history aglow. Basic classes offered include the skills of cutting, welding, bending and curving glass tubing. From these classes each student will head home with their own glowing work of art.


